Practice Teaching

Within two weeks of the completion of the final module of the final unit required for Certification, the Training Center will receive the Candidate's DDC Credentials. The Training Center is to monitor at least two complete programs taught by the instructor prior to signing and issuing the Certificate to the new instructor.
